- AFFLIGEM BLONDE** 8
Affligem is an authentic Belgian Abbey beer. Brewed since the 12th century and now produced by Affligem Brewery under licence from the Benedictine monks. Affligem Blonde is a classic Belgian ale with a deep golden colour and a full body. It is well balanced, with a sweetish, refreshing fruity flavour and a hoppy, dry finish. A beer that can be appreciated for its quality and character- yet remarkably easy to drink!

- BELL'S WINTER WHITE** 5

- HACKER-PSCHORR WEISS** 6
Hacker-Pschorr Weis is 100% natural and has a uniquely crisp, refreshing, smooth malty taste. brewed with pure spring water, Hacker-Pschorr uses a centuries-old exclusive yeast strain, Hallertau hops and 60% malted and wheat barley and 40% malted barley. A clovey nose of sweet malt greets your senses and awakens your palate.

- OLD STYLE** 3
Old Style employs the traditional brewing skills of the German craftsman. Kraeusened and well carbonated, Old Style is a beer that revives the crisp rich freshness of a classic Pilsner: light in color and body, medium in aroma and bitterness, full flavored with a delicate aftertaste.

- SAISON DUPONT** 9
Six or seven breweries make Saisons. The undisputed classic of the style is Saison Dupont. It comes from an artisanal brewery that is also a working farm (eggs are sold in the executive offices!) and produces beers with exquisitely hand-made character, and unruly clumpy yeast. When Saison Dupont first arrived in this country, we had to do quite a bit of explaining about the look of the beer. The brewery has cultured their yeast for taste and aromatic qualities. Because Dupont basically only sells beer from the brewery, they haven't concerned themselves with developing a yeast that travels well. For the uninitiated, the look of the beer is daunting. However, the sweetest rewards await the adventurous.

- ST-AMBROISE OATMEAL STOUT** 6
Brewed from 40 percent dark malts and roasted barley, this intensely black ale carries strong hints of espresso and chocolate. Oatmeal contributes body and a long-lasting mocha-colored head to this well-hopped beer.

A noble pils of golden color with a wonderful head and an excellent clean, crisp bouquet from using only the finest Saaz hops. An L&E staff favorite.

- THREE FLOYDS ROBERT THE BRUCE** 5
A bold Scottish ale with a complex malty body derived from roasted and crystal malts balanced with just the right combination of hops. This ale pours a deep ruby color, has a sweet malty nose with layered caramel and roasted notes and a full body. Robust yet smooth, Robert The Bruce is a malt lover's delight.

- TRIPLE KARMELIET** 9
Tripel Karmeliet is still brewed to an authentic beer recipe from 1679 originating in the former Carmelite monastery in Dendermonde. Written over 300 years ago, this recipe describes the user of three kinds of grain: wheat, oats and barley.

- UNIBROU CHAMBLY NOIRE** 7
Like good wine, Unibroue's fine beers have flavors that develop with age. Over time they become smoother, sometimes revealing notes of honey and candied fruit and developing a more assertive and lasting flavor. This phenomenon is known as "maderization" and is similar to the aging process of dessert wines like port. With its champagne-like bubbles, spices, low bitterness, and slightly chocolaty finish, Noire de Chambly is much milder than its appearance suggests. It's the perfect introduction to dark ales.
